Your donations were very well-received by families across our own school community.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Self-Isolation Rules</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Positive case = isolate for 10 days.</li> <li>• If fully vaccinated or under 18 years 4 months, exit quarantine if a LFT returns a negative result after day 6 <b>and</b> day 7.</li> <li>• Household contacts can return if they record negative daily lateral flows for 7 consecutive days.</li> <li>• Positive LFT/no symptoms=isolate.</li> <li>• Symptoms = book a PCR test.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Homework</b></p> <p>Following our recent survey, we have listened to your feedback and will return to paper homework tasks from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January. Staff will create monthly homework grids for the children to complete, but the children are expected to return homework jotters every week for correction. Staff will communicate what day of the week homework is due. Please support and encourage your child with their learning at home.</p>

Energy drinks and fizzy juice are not permitted in SLC schools.</p> </div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>P1 Registration</b></p> <p>Children who attain the age of 5 years between 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022 and 28<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023, should be registered to start school in August this year. 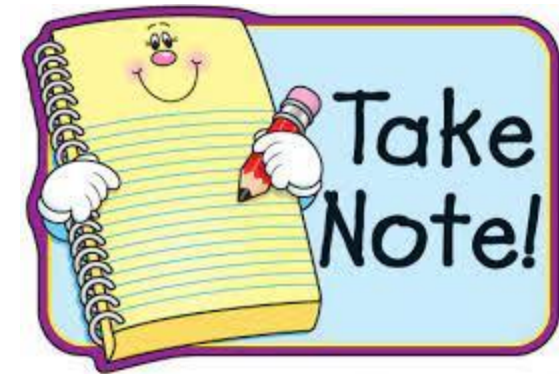
