Parent Council Meeting 5th Sept 2023 Head Teacher's Report

Welcome to new and returning members - thank you for your support.

A huge thank you to the Parent Council for organising a very successful Back to School BBQ on the first week of term - great opportunity to welcome everyone back and for us to network with new families.

Session 2023-2024

The school term has got off to a good start; the children are settling in well and adapting to their new class environment.

A warm welcome to Mrs Ogilvie, our new Principal Teacher who has responsibility for leading P1-3, including ASN and Nursery Transition. We would also like to welcome Miss Bogucu (NQT) and Mr Morrell who will be covering for Miss Huskie's Maternity Leave.

Standards and Quality/School Improvement Plan

Our Standards and Quality Report has now been published on our school website; detailing the successes of last session. This has also informed our new School Improvement Plan for this session. We have identified 4 key priorities:

- Developing Health and Wellbeing across the school community.
- Ensuring we have a progressive and enjoyable curriculum for all learners, with a greater emphasis on outdoor learning, play and digital technology.
- Working alongside schools in Learning Community to develop shared standards and expectations of Writing at all stages.
- Monitoring attendance and timekeeping.

Pupil Equity Fund

This year, we were allocated £57,000 Pupil Equity Fund.

£33,000 has been allocated to staffing to allow us to continue to provide nurturing interventions 3 days per week.

Approx £4,000 to develop Play

Approx £16,000 to develop inclusive libraries and top up reading books 5% allocated to pupils/parents to decide - Participatory Budgeting - trips, buses, clubs, etc. Council Savings 2023-2026 - impact budgets - buses, clubs, resources, etc.
